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Guidelines for International Commerce Olympiad (ICO) 2026–27 (Digital / Online Round)

Students are advised to carefully read and follow the instructions below to ensure a smooth and hassle-free attempt of the Digital Round of the International Commerce Olympiad (ICO) 2026–27.

1. Dates of Examination

Round 1: Sunday, 29th November 2026

Round 2: Sunday, 3rd January 2027

2. Examination Schedule – Class XI

4. Important Instructions

1. Students joining late will be allowed to attempt the examination; however, the duration available will be reduced accordingly. No extra time shall be provided.
2. It is strongly recommended to attempt the examination on a **Laptop, Desktop Computer, or Tablet** with a stable high-speed internet connection for the best experience.
3. Use **Google Chrome** browser for attempting the Olympiad.
4. Before logging in, clear your browser cache and browsing history.
5. **Do not attempt the examination on Apple devices, iPad, or Safari browser.**
6. For Class XII students, only those subjects for which they have been registered will be available in the examination portal.
7. There will be **negative marking of 0.25 marks** for every incorrect response. Students are advised to answer carefully.
8. **COMPLETION OF THE MOCK TEST IS COMPULSORY FOR ALL REGISTERED PARTICIPANTS. STUDENTS WHO FAIL TO ATTEMPT THE MOCK TEST WITHIN THE STIPULATED TIME SHALL NOT BE ELIGIBLE TO APPEAR IN THE INTERNATIONAL COMMERCE OLYMPIAD (ICO) ON THE PRESCRIBED EXAMINATION DATE.**

5. Restricted Activities

The following activities are strictly prohibited and may lead to **automatic submission of the test**:

1. Copying and pasting content during the examination.
2. Using Google Search or any other search engine while attempting the test.
3. Receiving or making phone calls during the examination.
4. Minimizing the examination window or switching screens.
5. Keeping the examination screen idle for more than 10 seconds.

Students are advised to remain focused on the examination screen throughout the test duration.
